	Area/Zone	Community & Culture of Respect	Safety
1	Front of School (Arriving By Bus/Wheels/Foot/Bus)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Respect &amp; maintain the landscape (all plants &amp; next to bike rack).</li> <li>2. Share the 24th Ave. sidewalk with the community (larger South Eugene). Stay above the stairs (instead of at the bottom of the stairs).</li> <li>3. Respect, maintain, &amp; share the bike racks because they belong to everyone. They cannot be claimed.</li> <li>4. Respect other people's property. Don't move or try to move someone else's bike.</li> <li>5. Bikes should be locked in the bike rack only.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Stairs are for feet only.</li> <li>2. Walk only in the entire plaza/front of the school.</li> <li>3. Bike rack areas are for bike riders only.</li> <li>4. Stay in designated areas, pathways, and lanes.</li> <li>5. Exit cars on the sidewalk side of the car if possible.</li> <li>6. Walk your wheels in designated spaces and pathways. The area immediately outside the front doors is for walking only.</li> </ol>
2	Gyms	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Follow posted gym instructions.</li> <li>2. Practice good sportsmanship.</li> <li>3. Use the bleachers as intended. They should not be climbed on at all.</li> <li>4. Use a stick with a hook to roll the balls out without climbing the bleachers.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Use the gym equipment as intended.</li> <li>2. Keep the gym equipment where it should be.</li> <li>3. Be careful with the doors that divide the gyms.</li> <li>4. Get permission from the teacher or supervisor before opening the exterior doors.</li> </ol>

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	Gyms	Ask a staff member for help.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>5. Leave lunch boxes out of the way.</li> <li>6. Equipment room requires adult supervision.</li> </ol>
3	Dining Hall, Cafe, & Patio	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Respect, maintain, &amp; share the space.</li> <li>2. Be respectful of the kitchen &amp; custodial staff (and everyone else). Say please &amp; thank you and make a nice environment.</li> <li>3. Respect the wildlife and landscaping.</li> <li>4. Please only sit on the concrete steps of the stage.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Clean up after yourself. Reset the space. Leave it better than you found it.</li> <li>2. Keep it inviting for others. Chairs &amp; stools should be in place when you leave.</li> <li>3. Keep all four legs of the stools on the ground.</li> <li>4. Stay from tree-to-tree when on the grass outside.</li> <li>5. The fence is not for climbing.</li> </ol> <p>Cafe Area:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The space is meant for sitting &amp; eating.</li> <li>2. Keep the pathways and hallways clear.</li> <li>3. The cement benches are for sitting.</li> </ol>
4	Courtyard	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Be mindful and respectful of classes in session.</li> <li>2. Reset the space. Leave it better than you found it. Keep it inviting for others.</li> <li>3. Bring appropriate objects like books, homework, and, during lunch, devices. Lockers are closed during lunch.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Play in the field or gym (not in the courtyard).</li> <li>2. Use quiet voices when class is in session.</li> <li>3. Use the path. Respect &amp; maintain the landscape.</li> <li>4. Walk.</li> </ol>

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5	Hallways, Stairs, & Breezeways, Break Out Space, Library Lounge	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Be mindful that other classes are in session. They should be allowed to stay focused.</li> <li>2. Be aware that you are sharing the space with others.</li> <li>3. Keep the furniture in place unless you've checked with a teacher.</li> <li>4. Reset the space. Leave it better than you found it. Keep it inviting for others.</li> <li>5. Remember that this is a highly visible space.</li> <li>6. Library lounge is closed before school until 8:30 and during lunch.</li> <li>7. Use the library lounge as a quiet workplace (extension of the library).</li> <li>8. Reset the library lounge. Leave it better than you found it. Keep it inviting for others.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Keep areas clean &amp; open.</li> <li>2. Be chill. No need to rush. Walk calmly. Do not run.</li> <li>3. Stay to the right of the hallways &amp; stairs while keeping your hands &amp; feet to self.</li> <li>4. The railings are for hands only.</li> <li>5. Keep your hands, belongings, and voice on one side of the railing. Nothing goes over the rail, including your voice.</li> <li>6. Use the furniture as intended.</li> <li>7. Keep pencils, pens, and other supplies away when walking in the halls.</li> <li>8. Step out of the flow of traffic if you need to stop when walking in the halls.</li> <li>9. Two students to a bench seat in the library lounge.</li> </ol>
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6	Forum & Commons	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Respect, maintain, &amp; share the space.</li> <li>2. Use appropriate voice level on all levels of the forum.</li> <li>3. Keep it inviting for others. This includes picking up trash, not vandalizing, and picking up your belongings.</li> <li>4. This is the only area open until 8:30. Be mindful of others' space.</li> <li>5. Respect the displays.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The stairs are for walking &amp; the steps are for sitting. (Steps are the larger ones.)</li> <li>2. The railings are for hands only, not sliding.</li> <li>3. Access the forum steps by using the stairs to the right of the railing.</li> <li>4. Mind your space and others as you are walking. Be chill. No need to rush.</li> <li>5. Keep backpacks tucked away so no one trips.</li> </ol>
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
