

Suggested Talking Points for Calls to 6th graders (3-5 min conversation):

Introduce yourself! Let them know that you are going to be their advisor at Roosevelt (and how excited/happy you are about this!) :)

This means, as your advisor for the next three years (kind of like home room teacher), I will be the person who will be looking out for you, help you with concerns, problems, questions. You will be a part of a house community made up of 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students.

You could let them know you are looking forward to meeting them on Wednesday the 5th. On that day it will only be 6th graders. Your day will look like this:

CORE (Creating Our Roosevelt Environment) Orientation from 8:55-3:30 with their 8th grade peers! You should have or will receive a call by your student CORE leader telling you all about Roosevelt orientation.

Remind them not to bring a backpack. They could bring a water bottle and writing utensil .

House 9:15 - 10:00 - This will be a chance to meet you and their other 6th grade house mates, to get lockers, planners, and their school schedule.

There will be a free lunch served that day. They may bring a lunch if they have special dietary needs. If so, they can leave their lunch in the office.

A reminder to make sure they have all of their school supplies by the first day of classes. Let them know that we can help them get any of the supplies they made need (no a worry, to just let you know).
